# PSO Bluebills Raise \$28,811 for Dove House

The 10th Annual Dove House Golf Benefit was held on Friday, August 19 at the Port Ludlow Golf Course. 128 players paid entry fees, spent money on opportunities to improve their scores, and bought raffle tickets. Nineteen major sponsors and twenty three tee sponsors wrote checks directly to Dove House.

A total of \$28,811 was raised through these efforts and a check was presented to Dove House. According to Bekka Bloom with Dove House "100% of this net revenue goes toward providing the varied resources and services that help survivors of domestic violence, sexual assault, and other types of crime to heal and rebuild their lives."

The 11th Annual Dove House Golf Benefit is set for Friday, August 18, 2023 at the Port Ludlow golf Course.

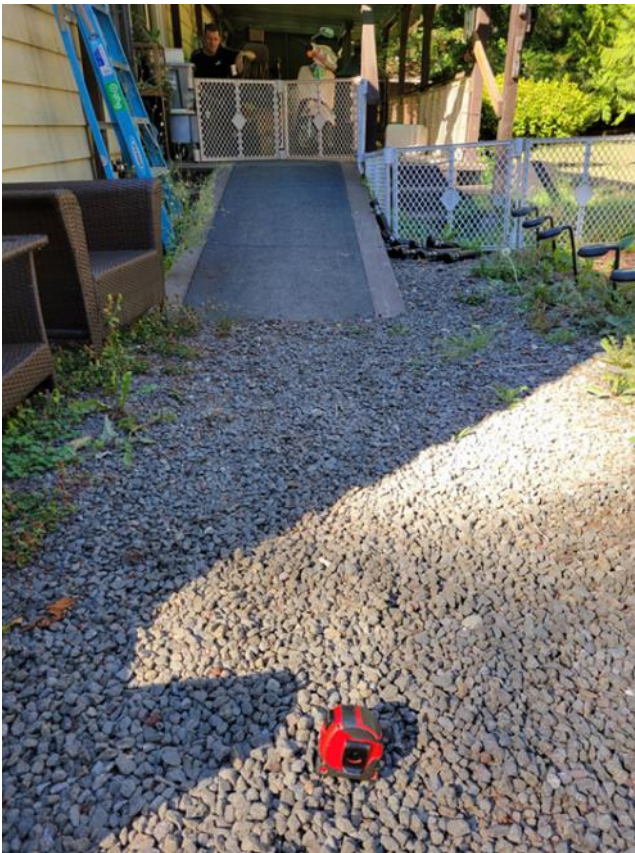

## Too Steep Ramp

A ramp that is too short results in a steep grade that will not only take more effort to safely navigate, but could lead to injury if a fall occurs. The ADA recommends a 1:12 slope ratio, which means that for every inch of rise, the ramp should extend out one foot.

In addition to requests to inspect and fix ramps that are in need of repair, we sometimes get a request to look at a ramp that a client is having trouble with because it is too steep. In extreme cases it may not be much more than a sheet of plywood set over the stair steps.

This Poulsbo client had a relative put a ramp in for him but it was 2x too steep and he was having trouble negotiating it. Usually this situation requires a complete tear down and all-new ramp, but this one was well built and in good shape. Since it was already tapered we were able to slide it out and splice in a new section up at the top. We also added handrails, and the client feels much more comfortable with this stretched version.



Original Ramp – tape (red) measure shows where a proper 1:12 slope ramp would end.



New Ramp – almost double in length and with added railings.
